

VILLAGE OF CASNOVIA

An ordinance to regulate dogs within the Village of Casnovia.

The Village of Casnovia:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons who own, possess, harbor, or have the care of any dog or other animal in the Village of Casnovia to allow the said dog or other animal to run loose and unattended on the streets of the said Village to the extent of becoming a public nuisance or a traffic hazzard.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to own a dog in the Village of Casnovia which by loud and frequent barking, howling, yelping, growling or any noise, cause serious annoyance to any of the people of the said Village.

Section 3. Any peace officer of the said Village is herby authorized to impound any such dog or other animal and to hold the same impounded for three (3) days, during which time the person entilted may redeem such animal by paying the reasonable costs of impounding. If not so redeemed, the peace officer shall dispose of such animal.

Section 4. Any person or persons who violate the terms of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not to exceed \$100.00 or shall be confined in any jail or workhouse in the County of their residence (Kent or Muskegon), State of Michigan, for a period not to exceed 90 days, or shall suffer both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
