

ORDINANCE NO. 1966-2

An Ordinance to regulate the parking of motor vehicles within the Village of Casnovia, between the hours of 2 A.M. and 6 A.M., and to provide penalties for the violation thereof, and repealing all Ordinances in conflict herewith.


THE VILLAGE OF CASNOVIA ORDAINS:


Section 1. In order to permit the Village to properly maintain public streets and alleys in the most expedient manner, no person shall park a vehicle on any street or alley open to public traffic in the Village between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.

Section 2. Failure to observe this Ordinance will constitute a misdemeanor and vehicles so parked in violation of this ordinance will be impounded by the police department. Vehicles so impounded may be recovered by payment of a fine and payment of towing charges incurred in the impounding of the vehicle.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after its passage.
